ONE ROOF MEETS COMMUNITY NEEDS

One Roof is a non-profit ministry located in Newnan, Georgia. It is made up of a coalition of churches, businesses, and individuals who see a need for a benevolence ministry in our community. Residents of Coweta may apply to receive assistance for rent, mortgage payments, a power bill, a prescription or other basic necessities.

One Roof Intake Office provides screening and counseling in order to better serve our clients. We work with other agencies in the community to coordinate benefits and they also refer people to us.

One Roof Resale House is our thrift store and is located in our building. We sell donated clothing and household items at a low

price. We also give away clothing and other items to people who qualify. The thrift store generates income that helps to cover the cost of overhead for operating this ministry. Come visit our Resale Store and check out the nice clothing, household accessories, books, toys, and other items we sell. Everything you purchase helps another person in our community. Our clothing items are all priced at \$1.00 each.

Families are Struggling



The Coweta Community Food Pantry which has provided food for community for 26 years is also located within our building. The Food Pantry has its own Board of Directors and its own funding. One Roof Intake Office provides screening for those applying for food and then the food pantry supplies that need.

Frequently Asked Questions

How can someone qualify for help?

One Roof intake provides screening and forms for applying for assistance.

Do you keep track of people who come to you for help?

We like to follow up with the people we assist. Some people have been able to get back on their feet quickly after short term help. Others need different assistance, and we refer them to other organizations if there is a need that we cannot meet. We also have a database that is being compiled for the use of our partner organizations.

Have you received any federal money to help with your work?

We received two grants; one from the United Way and one through

FEMA in 2009. These grants have specific uses and people must qualify to receive assistance through them. For example, one grant required that recipients must be working but need assistance with utility bills or rent/mortgage payments only. In 2009, we were able to use \$35,389 in grant money here in Coweta County.



Who works at One Roof?

Derenda Rowe is the Executive Director and we have two part time employees. We rely on volunteers to help keep our donations sorted and the Resale Store stocked. We have also been fortunate to have part time helpers who are paid through grants from another organization. We have a volunteer registration system if you are interested in participating.

Are my contributions tax deductible?

Yes, all contributions of cash and property are tax deductible. We can provide you with a signed receipt useful for your tax return. We welcome your donations. Know that your donations help families right here in Coweta County.
