Last Sunday was Annual Appeal Commitment Sunday.

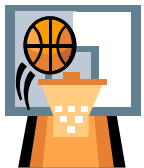

NO, each session stands on it's own. It does not matter if you begin with session 1 or 10.

I don't know anyone in the group.

These are designed to be small faith communities, non intimidating, run by mom's, dad's, and other regular people. They are looking forward to meeting you!

I don't like to talk in groups.

No one is ever forced to share. We all grow from other people's sharing of their God and life experience. Only when you want to should you!

We have kids so we can't go.

The Parish is providing childcare Thursday mornings at church. You can join a session at church or start a group in a home nearby. Do potluck and hire a sitter as a group.

I travel and will miss sessions so I won't bother.

The booklets are designed so that you can home study as needed. Again, each session is independent of the others.
