Narthex Entry Chandelier...Full Sponsor : \$30,000, Partial Sponsor: \$ 3,750

Formed in the shape of the Jerusalem Cross, this one-of-a-kind lighting fixture has a bronze finish and faux alabaster globes. It measures nine feet square and hangs from a central canopy. The chandelier serves as the main source of light for the narthex and is visible through the three gothic-shaped windows. It is the central point to our entryway from both inside and out of the main entrance.

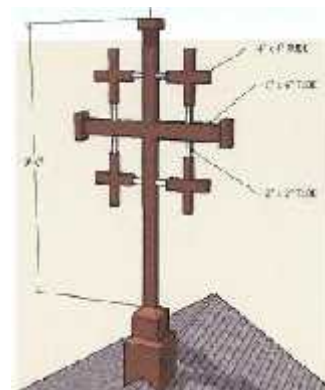
Gathering Circle ...Full Sponsorship: \$35,900, Partial Sponsorship: \$ 3,000

SAN DAMIANO CRUCIFIX

The San Damiano Cross has been chosen to be the major focal point of the church

interior, first seen even before entering the actual worship space. It is rich in tradition and our own Mary Magdalene is included among the multiple images portrayed on this icon.

As legend has it, one day God spoke to St. Francis through the crucifix in the chapel of San Damiano, just outside the walls of Assisi, Italy and said, "Francis, rebuild my church." This was a literal request to repair the chapel which had fallen into ruin, but is also interpreted metaphorically as a divine command to renew the life of the church as the people of God.

The crucifix became known as the San Damiano Cross, and is considered an icon because it contains the images of people who participate in its meaning. In addition to the crucified Christ, these images include the major witnesses, who themselves were at the foot of the cross, including: Mary, the mother of Jesus; St. John, the "beloved disciple", Mary Magdalene; Mary, the mother of James, and the centurion who proclaimed, "Truly this is the son of God".

The original crucifix now hangs in the Basilica of Santa Chiara (St. Clare) in Assisi. We join St. Francis in cherishing this cross as a symbol of our mission from God.

- An extended pledge period may be arranged if necessary.
- You may also choose to make a one-time cash donation to the Honor/Memorial fund or a general pledge to the campaign.
