Saint Agnes met on February 21, celebrating with a heavy brunch for Mardi Gras. Our special guest was Deacon Steve Swope who gave us a very inspiring message about Lent. He reminded us that the whole focus of Lent should be a closer relationship with God, not a sad period of punishing ourselves. In addition to any sacrifice we might want to make, the valuable points I took away from his talk included making a small changes in our lives that can give us the opportunity for spiritual growth: setting aside daily time for prayer - 10 minutes is a good start, and sitting quietly just listening to what God may want to say to us. This may start with reading a scripture or reading the daily readings and picking out a topic, word or sentence to reflect on before our prayerful meditation. Our fasting/almsgiving could include sacrificing a meal and putting that money into the CRS boxes we can pick up in the narthex starting tomorrow. Another suggestion he plans to incorporate this Lent is making a list of 40 people in your life and writing a note (and mailing it!) to one of them everyday to let them know they are important in your life.

We had five guests who decided to join our lively, joyful group! Next meeting in March Theresa Weeks will give us a presentation on the Eucharist. Theresa is the trainer and coordinator of the Extraordinary Ministers.
